Katherine H. Ingram, Ph.D., Assistant Professor, Department of Exercise Science and Sport Management, received the 2014 KSU Foundation Prize for the WellStar College of Health and Human Services on August 14, 2014. This prize is awarded each year to a single individual or team who exhibits excellence in academic publications. Dr. Ingram was co-author of "Limitations in the use of indices using glucose and insulin levels to predict insulin sensitivity: impact of race and gender and superiority of the indices derived from oral glucose tolerance test in African Americans", published in *Diabetes Care*, April 2013. Dr. Ingram's continuing research and contributions to her department are in the area of obesity, physical activity, and diabetes. Her long-range academic goal is to encourage students to understand and explore relationships between physical activity and health.

Dr. Barbara Blake, Professor of Nursing in the WellStar School of Nursing, earned recognition for her work in the area of HIV prevention, treatment, and care. In November, at the Association of Nurses in AIDS Care (ANAC) annual convention that is being held in Miami, Dr. Barbara Blake will receive the ANAC HIV Educator Distinguished Service Award. This award recognizes her expertise and dedication in educating not only students, but the community about HIV.
