<p>Take the Initial Knowledge Check (IKC) as soon as possible, and do the remaining topics for each deadline by completing Unit Homework by 11:59 pm on the due dates to receive full credit for learning it BY THE DEADLINE. Your best chance for success in the class comes from doing honest work in ALEKS.</p>
<p>Having completed the learning for each of the Homework assignments for those Units that lead into each test, spend a little time reviewing that learning and then take the Test Review KC. The results from this knowledge check will show you the topics in those objectives you were going to miss on the Test if that question is on the test. Revisit those topics that show learning needed.</p>
<p>Use any time after taking the TRKC (Test # Review Knowledge Check) to begin your last review for test by checking each previous unit for any topics that show up as needed to be Learned or relearned as the case may be. This review will help you understand your own readiness and remediate the topics that you dont know how to do.</p>
<p>Plan for having completed all Homework, Test Review Knowledge Check, and leave time to review the TRKC results to know what to study before the test</p>
<p>Make sure you have done enough work to get this grade as 100%. The goal percentage (meaning your current Progress Report %) needs to be at least 55% to get 100% of the points for the Midterm Progress goal, and 100% to get that score for the Final Progress goal just before the final.</p>

Tips for Success	
	<p>Always know how many topics remain in the learning path for each Unit as you PLAN for enough time to get the work done. Learn your own learning rate after you take the knowledge check (KC) after the IKC.</p>
	<p>Plan to take this after learning everything in the Units leading into it. Do it as soon as you have finished learning but early enough to make sure it is done with enough time to use the results.</p>
	<p>Last chance period to catch up and finalize your preparation for each test. During this period, you can work backwards to go recover topics that were not learned or need more practice.</p>
	<p>DO YOUR BEST having learned the topics on time(yellow), used the TKC's to check your retention before Tests (purple) and picked up refreshed knowledge during the post KC review period.</p>
	<p>DO YOUR BEST! Prepare for course by making sure to learn ALL of the topics in the course on time, but if you are late, this category will help you make up some portion of the points that were not gained by learning topics on time.</p>
