

## Master of Science in Integrative Biology

The [Green Quantitative Ecology Lab](#) at **Kennesaw State University** (KSU) is recruiting a master's student to start in Fall 2023. This student will work on an ongoing project investigating spatial and physiological ecology of small mammals along urban-rural gradients. This position has TA support for 2 years.

### Qualifications:

Required qualifications include: BS or BA in biology or related field, with GPA  $\geq 3.0$  (out of 4.0); research experience in biology or related field; undergraduate coursework in ecology, statistics, and calculus. Preferred qualifications include: experience with small mammal field research, R programming, and GIS.

### Program information:

Students will be enrolled in the KSU Master of Science in Integrative Biology (MSIB) program, within the KSU College of Science and Mathematics. KSU is located about 30 miles northwest of Atlanta in Cobb County near historic Kennesaw Mountain, allowing students to experience the best of Atlanta while enjoying the serenity of a 384-acre, beautifully landscaped pedestrian-friendly campus.

The [MSIB program](#) at Kennesaw State University is looking for students determined to solve tomorrow's life science problems. Our degree is designed specifically to integrate concepts and information from various disciplines (e.g. genomics, physiology, ecology) at different scales (e.g. molecular, cellular, organismal, ecosystematic). Students center their experience in a thesis focused on a specific research question. This combination prepares scientists equipped to make the discoveries that address the most urgent issues in the biosciences.

Send an email that includes the following: 1) your current CV; 2) a cover letter (up to 1 page) describing your interest in the position and how it fits with your career plans; and 3) contact information for 2 professional references. Materials must be received by Wednesday, January 4, 2023. I will review applications and interview applicants the week of January 9, and the selected applicant will apply for priority admission to the MSIB program by Sunday January 15.
